Notice of Proposed Ordinance No. 38 – Vendors

Proposed Ordinance No. 38 was introduced at a regular meeting of the Watertown Charter Township Board of Trustees on January 16, 2012, and will be considered for adoption at their next regularly scheduled meeting which will take place on Tuesday, February 21, 2012 at 7:00pm.

Proposed Ordinance No. 38 would add Chapter 27 – Vendors – and Article I – Generally, Sections 27-1, 27-2, 27-3, 27-4, 27-5, 27-6, 27-7, and 27-8, and Article II – License – Sections 27-31, 27-32, 27-33, 27-34, 27-35, 27-36, 27-37, 27-37, and 27-39 to the Code of Ordinances, Charter Township of Watertown, Clinton County, Michigan, to define, regulate and license vendors.

For your reference, this ordinance would define “vending” as follows: the act of offering merchandise for sale from a fixed place not within a building, from a vehicle or from a fixed place in a tent, canopy or similar shelter, not including merchants offering merchandise for sale upon commercial premises permanently occupied by them; and the act of offering merchandise for immediate sale, or for sale by sample, description or otherwise for delivery or sale at a future time, by going from door to door, house to house, person to person, car to car, or by any other closely related manner; not including the act of offering merchandise for wholesale to retailers or for resale to manufacturers for use in their processes; also not including regular route delivery persons delivering products.
